WHAT TO DO?

To organize an **on line** activity related to Corrosion Science and Engineering in your Research Institute, University, Industry, City, Province... to be launched in the frame of the Corrosion Awareness Day (24th April).

The activity includes (but not limited to): articles in (local) newspapers or in technical and scientific journals, on websites of the corrosion societies but also of other societies (chemical, engineering, materials, etc.). The main goal is to raise awareness about corrosion and corrosion protection around the world.

We will help you to advertise and make visible your activity all around the world. We will post the event at the EFC and WCO website platforms. Furthermore, both official organizations will provide a certificate to the organizers of the event.

Examples of activities: dissemination articles, on-line dissemination talks, on line workshops, photo competition, articles in scientific & technical journals or in newspapers, videos of corrosion experiments, webinars, etc.



HOW TO DO IT? STEPS:

1. As soon as possible:

Send the following information:

- A tentative title of the activity with a brief description (max. 100 words);
- Link to the event (if possible);
- The name and affiliation of the organizers (max. 3 people);

The information will be advertised on the EFC and WCO online platforms.

2. From April 24th to June 30th

Send the summary of the activity (max. 200 words). The summary will be posted online using the EFC and WCO platforms.

3. Upon receipt of the summary

The organizers will receive a certificate validated by the EFC and WCO.
